## Our Patroness

The school is christened after Blessed Virgin Mary, Our Lady of Mount Carmel. Blessed with a profound faith in the Almighty, Mother Mary is an exemplar and precedent of true discipleship. After her example and through her patronage, Carmel is striving to initiate her students in the path of wisdom.

## Founder

Kuriakose Elias Chavara, C.M.I. (10 February 1805 – 3 January 1871) is an Indian Catholic priest and social reformer. He is the first canonized Catholic male saint of Indian ancestry and belongs to the Syro-Malabar Catholic Church, an Eastern Catholic Church based in the state of Kerala. He was the co-founder and first Prior General of the first congregation for men in the Syro-Malabar Catholic Church, now known as the Carmelites of Mary Immaculate (C.M.I.), and of a similar one for women, the Congregation of the Mother of Carmel (C.M.C.).

## Examination and Reports

'A1' Grade Badges and certificates will be awarded to the eligible students for their commendable achievements in exams. Pupils are promoted on the basis of the whole year's performance. Much importance is given to Terminal and Mid-Terminal Examination marks. Attendance and regularity in work also have due weightage in the promotion norms.
